Livelihoods India

Initiated in 2010 by ACCESS Development Services, Livelihoods India is a national level platform that brings together various stakeholders to discuss and deliberate on key issues that impede the livelihoods of those living in poverty, and build a strategy and vision for moving them from subsistence to sustainable levels. A major initiative under Livelihoods India is the flagship annual Livelihoods India Summit, a pre-eminent national level platform engaging stakeholders, to share knowledge, support policy, and build an enabling environment for the sector.

Livelihoods India Summit

The Livelihoods India Summit is a premier national level convening for fostering dialogues and discussions for sustainable livelihoods promotion. Across two days, the Summit brings together delegates and thought leaders, through a series of sessions styled as panel discussions, fireside chats and TED style talk, to delve into the most pressing themes that impede and afflict the livelihoods of those living in poverty. The Summit is also the ground for the release of cutting-edge research and knowledge products on Women's Economic Empowerment, MSMEs, and FPOs among others. The Resource Directory, featuring sector experts and partner organizations further enhances networking, collaboration and knowledge-sharing.

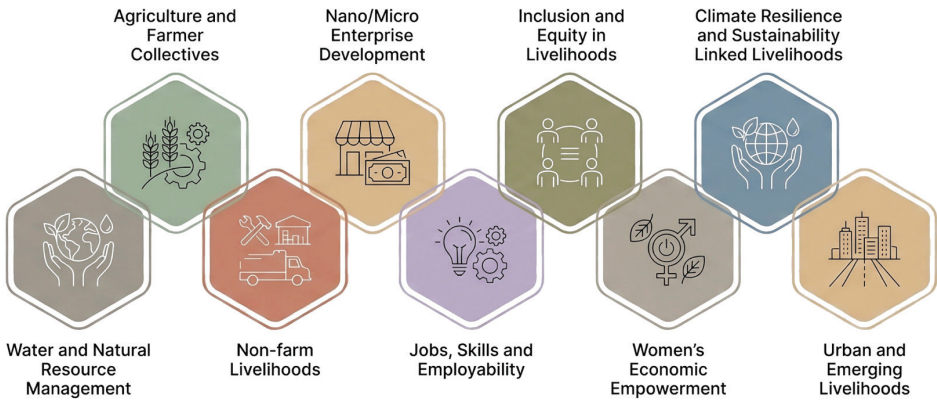

The SOIL Report is an annual publication, released at the Inaugural Session of the Livelihoods India Summit. It addresses contemporary livelihoods issues, identifying opportunities to transition from subsistence to sustainable models through year-over-year analysis of government policy initiatives, current trends, and challenges. Over the years, the SOIL Report has emerged as an important reference document, comprehensively discussing livelihoods promotion efforts in India.



Retreats, Roundtables, Thematic Conferences



To facilitate in-depth discussions around themes of policy importance, thematic conferences, policy retreats, and roundtables are held from time to time. In the recent past, partnerships with relevant stakeholders have included smaller format engagements and discussions around non-farm livelihoods, women's economic empowerment, and agricultural technology amongst others.

FPO Impact Award

The Awards, instituted in 2018 are one-of-a-kind felicitation to recognise and encourage exemplary FPOs that have overcome challenges to successfully build self-sustaining businesses and contribute meaningfully to the farmer members. These also felicitate FPO promoting institutions that strengthen the ecosystem, shape policy, promote scalable models, and incubate innovations for FPO growth.

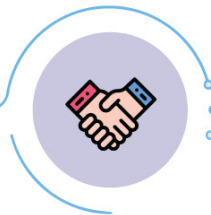

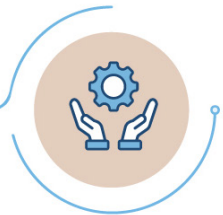

ACCESS Development Services

ACCESS Development Services is a national level livelihoods support organisation headquartered in New Delhi, with a focus on incubating innovations for promoting sustainable livelihoods of those living in poverty. Set up in 2006, with support from DFID (Govt. of UK), ACCESS is structured uniquely, to work at all levels of the development sector value chain.

At Tier I, ACCESS directly engages with the communities by implementing programmes on ground. Over the past two decades, ACCESS has established its identity as one of India's leading livelihoods-promoting organisations. Currently, ACCESS operates across 14 states, implements 36 ongoing programmes, and has directly impacted over 18 lakh lives.

At Tier II, ACCESS provides techno-managerial services to large bilateral/multilateral programmes, builds the institutional capacity, undertakes studies, and develops training curriculums for a public good. At Tier III, ACCESS seeks to strengthen the enabling environment through supportive policy, knowledge sharing and ecosystem level initiatives. While annually it organises two national/international level Summits and brings out annual reports on livelihoods and financial inclusion, it also organises policy roundtables, and thematic retreats, among others to build consensus on strategies that will deliver sustainable outcomes.

ACCESS completed two decades of purposeful growth in 2026 with a strong institutional foundation, a proven portfolio of programmes, deep relationships with communities, governments, donors, and sector partners and a strong professional cadre. The milestone reflects continuity of the mission that has driven the organisation. ACCESS continues to advance its commitment to scale impact, widen reach, and strengthen livelihoods ecosystems.
